Artboard Dimensions: 6.25in x 9.25in

Final Trim Size: 6in x 9in

- During the printing process, the postcard will be trimmed to be exactly 6in x 9in

Text Margin: 0.25in (0.125in on final trim)

- This margin ensures that text, logos and important design elements are not cut off during the printing process
